Annemette Danielsen holds a Master in Education. Her sector focus is education and protection with rights as the particular point of entry.

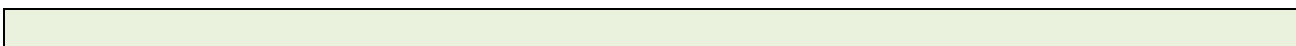
- She has extensive experience in conducting reviews and evaluations

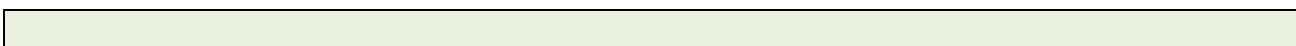
